

COACH DRIVER INFORMATION



Weston-super-Mare Carnival - a spectacle of light, music and colour!

Friday 9 November 2019

Advice for coach drivers:

- Locking Road Coach Park is closed from Monday 5th November 2018 up to and including Saturday 10th November 2018. Limited coach parking is available at Madeira Car Park (BS23 2HA).
- On the Friday official coach parking for the carnival is on Marine Parade (BS23 1BE). Our map shows the route to Marine Parade and the official coach parking area for carnival night. Coach parking is available from 12 noon.
Please follow directional signage from junction 21 and junction 22, M5. Charges apply. **No other coach parking is available in the town.**
- Town centre roads close at 6pm. Follow the signed route to avoid road closures.
- Procession starts at 7.15pm.
- On arrival an official will collect your parking fee:
£35 (coaches)
£15 (mini buses)
- The fee goes to carnival charity funds. You will be given a receipt and directed to your parking position. **Permit holders are exempt from this payment.**

VIP permit only parking

'On Route' parking on the promenade is reserved strictly for permit holders only.

- £50 for mini-buses of 16 seats or under (no campervans)
- £130 for coaches over 17 seats

Parking in this restricted area will not be allowed until 4pm, or until allowed by officials. No access will be available after 6pm so please arrive early.

Permits must be displayed.

Permits allow parking in the general coach parking area until it's time to transfer.

Important:

No coaches will be allowed on the promenade surface unless the operator has a 'spill kit' or absorbent matting. Vehicles with oil leaks will be refused entry by North Somerset Council who will do inspections on the day.

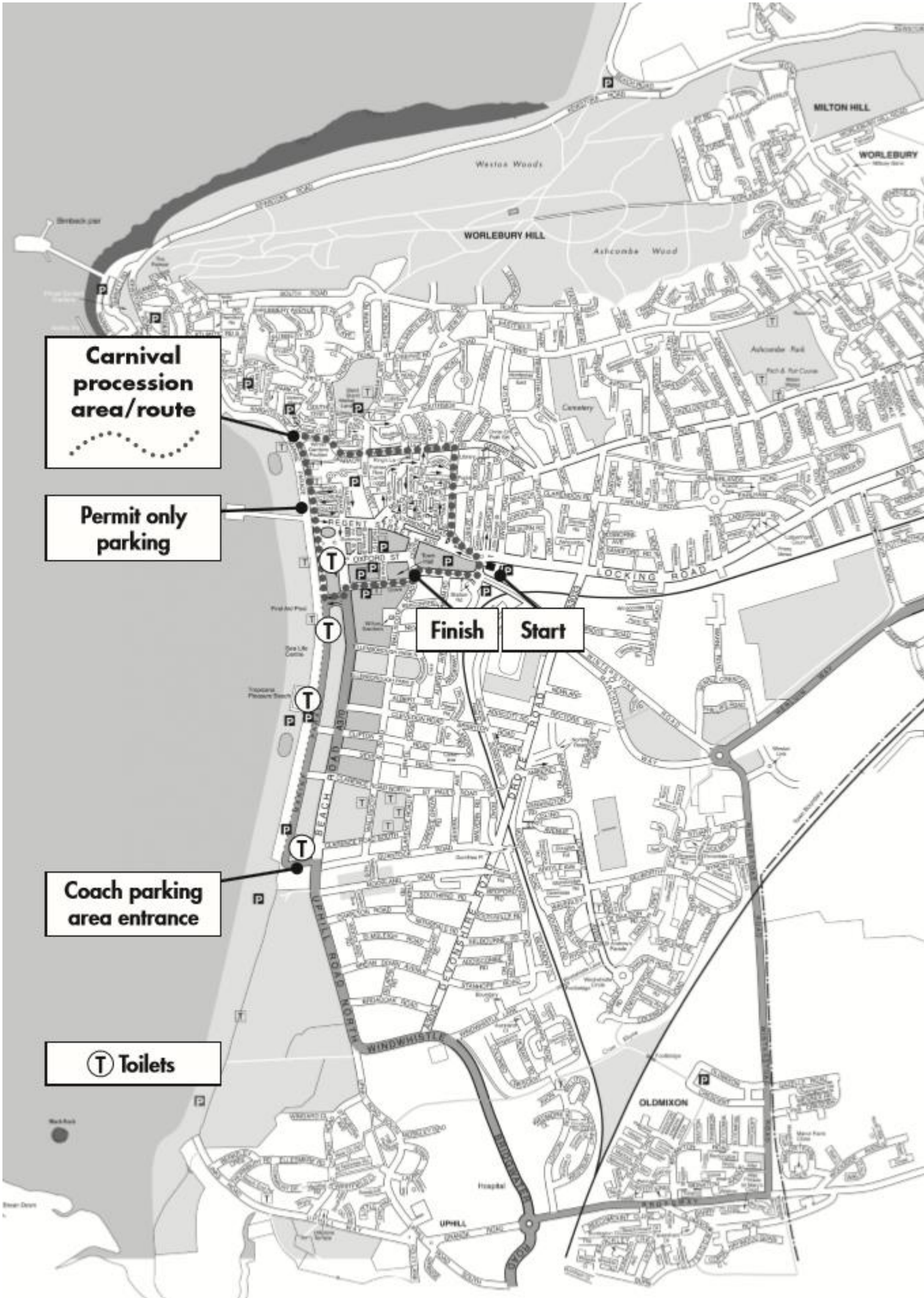
